## REGULAR MEETING OF UKRAINIAN PANCREATIC CLUB

25–26 of April 2013 year Chernovtsy was held a meeting of Ukrainian pancreatology Club, which was attended by more than 300 doctors from Bukovina, and from Lviv, Ivano-Frankivsk, Ternopil, from the Carpathians. We arrived as guests of Kiev, Zaporozhye, Kirovograd, Kherson, Donetsk and other cities and regions. The meeting was also attended by doctors from Moldova.

The meeting was open to the anniversary greetings professor T.N. Hristich. The inauguration was attended by representatives of the administration of Bukovina State Medical University, Chernivtsi Regional Health Department, Bukovina Society of Physicians, colleagues and students of Tamara Nikolaevna.

The scientific program was opened by the President of the Club' report on the news of the world pancreatology based on the meeting of the European Club pancreatology (Prague, June 2012). Special attention was paid to the epidemiology of pancreatic diseases, diagnosis and treatment of pancreatic insufficiency, a combination of disease of the pancreas with the metabolic syndrome, the differential diagnosis of pseudotumor pancreatitis.

Professor T.N. Hristich (Chernivtsi) spoke about the features of the treatment of chronic pancreatitis and coronary heart disease. Professor I.G. Paly (Vinnitsa), presented the choice of proton pump inhibitor in clinical practice in terms of safety. Professor N.B. Gubergrits (Donetsk) spoke about the place of pantoprazole in the treatment of chronic pancreatitis, as well as the pathogenesis and treatment of intestinal dysbiosis in chronic pancreatitis.

Great interest was attracted report of associate professor of medical sciences L.G. Tofan-Scutaru (Moldova) on the interaction between chronic pancreatitis and latent HBV infection.

Next were reports of Professor A.I. Fediv (Chernivtsi) a combination of fatty liver disease and pancreatic cancer, professor N.B. Gubergrits of functional hyperbilirubinemia, the therapeutic possibilities of a complex preparation of plant origin of Syrin, about taking drug Gepadif in gastroenterology, hepatology and pancreatology. His experience in the treatment of gastric dyspepsia combined with deodunogastroesophageal reflux disease reflux shared professor V.N. Chernobrovy. The results of their research on the correction of enteropancreatic manifestations of the syndrome in chronic pancreatitis presented professor L.S. Babinets (Ternopil). Professor E.E. Samogalskaya (Ternopil) reported on the flow characteristics of the combined pathology of the liver and pancreas.

The second day of the meeting was opened with a report of our guests from Russia, Doctor of Medicine of L.V. Vinokourov (Moscow) spoke about the influence of genetic factors on the formation of complications in chronic pancreatitis.

I.E. Trubitsyna (Moscow) reported on the use of stem cells in experimental acute and chronic pancreatitis. Next there were reports of professor of V.I. Vdovichenko (Lvov) of non-alcoholic fatty liver disease and pancreatic cancer, professor N.B. Gubergrits about the treatment of GERD refractory to proton pump inhibitors, Candidate of Medical Science O.A. Golubova (Donetsk) on the effect of caffeine on the status of the various organs and systems, Doctor of Medicine G.V. Osedlo (Kiev) on extraesophageal "mask" GERD, professor T.N. Hristich about the role of the cytokine level in the development of chronic pancreatitis and pancreatic cancer in its non-alcoholic fatty disease.

Candidate of Medical Science N.V. Belyaeva (Donetsk) spoke on the use of Eglonil in the treatment of chronic pancreatitis. Reports of Candidate of Medical Science O.V. Shvets focused on dietary fiber and prebiotics in a healthy diet and treatment of diseases of the digestive system, as well as advanced capabilities of

the management of patients with obesity. Professor N.B. Gubergrits reported on the peculiarities of the clinical use of the drug Ezolong, as well as the treatment of duodenal ulcers in combination with H. pylori infection and giardiasis. Candidate of Medical Science L.Y. Gladkyay (Kiev) gave a presentation on ultrasound differential diagnosis of chronic pancreatitis in combination with atherosclerosis and connective tissue disorders.

The conference was finished with televised question and answer session. Outstanding pancreatology professor J. E. Dominguez-Munoz (Spain) gave a lecture on the diagnosis and treatment of exocrine pancreatic insufficiency.

27of April President of the Club held a seminar on the basics of pancreatology for doctors of Western Ukraine and Moldova. Clinical analysis was conducted in patients with chronic pancreatitis and coarctation of the aorta. In parsing Gastroenterologists, internists, surgeons attended part in this discussion.

The meeting is traditionally accompanied by discussions, expressing opinions, outlining their own experience of doctors and ended with the issuance of certificates.
